OpenWater and Zoom, GSA Virtual Conference 2020



The OpenWater conference platform uses Zoom. There is no link; you just click on the session you want to enter (if you click on the session before its scheduled time, you will receive the message to wait until its start time; moderators can open the Zoom room up to 15 minutes in advance).

Although you can use the web version of Zoom, downloading the application to your device will offer you more connection stability. The <u>free version of</u> <u>Zoom</u> will work as well as the business (e.g. university) version.

If you already have the Zoom application, consider upgrading to the most

recent version for the best connectivity. 1. Sign in to Zoom: Thi. 2. At the top corner of the page, click on the initials or photo that takes you to your profile. 5:39 PM 3.
